

Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs/Schools

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List of Recognized Educational Programs/Schools/w/Revisions (Current Status as of June, 1986)

The accreditation program for nurse anesthesia was initiated in 1952 by the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists (AANA) and subsequently listed in the U.S. Commissioner of Education's list of nationally recognized accrediting agencies until 1975. The accreditation function was transferred to the Council on Accreditation on Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs/Schools in 1975 in response to a major revision of the U.S. Office of Education Criteria for Nationally Recognized Accrediting Agencies. The Council is presently in compliance with the U.S. Department of Education (formerly U.S. Office of Education) criteria and is listed by that body as a nationally recognized accrediting agency. The purpose of such recognition falls under the federal legislative mandate for that body to determine reliable authorities as to the quality of training offered by educational institutions and programs to determine eligibility for federal funding under selected legislation.

The Council on Accreditation has received a five-year approval for recognition as a specialized accrediting agency by the Council on Post-ondary Accreditation in October, 1985.

he Council on Accreditation is an autonomous multidisciplinary accrediting body which exists under the corporate structure of the AANA. This multidisciplinary structure of the Council and its policies give recognition to the interdependency of related professions and society by providing for broad input and participation by the profession's community of interest. We believe that private voluntary multidisciplinary groups which include public representation may coalesce effectively to serve the public through the accreditation process.

The Council on Accreditation publishes this list of accredited nurse anesthesia programs on a biannual basis as information for the public, other agencies and prospective students. A definition of the accreditation actions conferred follows:

Preaccreditation status signifies successful completion of a capability study and an onsite visit with authorization to accept students.

Initial accreditation status signifies programs that have had students in the practicum for one year and have successfully completed an onsite visit.

Accreditation status signifies that programs have successfully completed the pre and initial accreditation process. This status may be awarded for periods of one to four years.

Announced Public Probation signifies one or more of the following: serious deficiencies which jeopardize the quality of the educational process; failure of a Program to respond by the specified date to a Summary Report which identifies serious deficiencies; or failure to submit a Self Study, a Progress Report or an Interim Study by the due date.

Revocation of accreditation status signifies a program which does not present sufficient evidence of educational quality nor intent to comply with the Standards and Guidelines.

Administrative Extension (ADMEXT) signifies that the accreditation process cannot be completed prior to the expiration of the accreditation status through no fault of either the Program of the Council.
